Making Sure You Get Paid

Join the SBCA Workshop Series where SBCA legal counsel Kent Pagel will cover the following:

- 1. A look at common contract provisions utilized by contractors and builders to condition payment in some way. Examples include payment due provisions, pay if paid clauses, pay when paid clauses, and retainage provisions,
- 2. Understanding joint check agreements. A joint check agreement with a turnkey framer for example will only ensure payment to you if the agreement is written in such a way.
- 3. Making sure you preserve your lien rights along the way. Lien rights and bond claims are time and document sensitive, but if done correctly you drastically increase your chances of getting paid on that problematic project.
