SBCA

Regular Member: Any firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of the manufacture and sale of wood trusses, wall panels, related structural components and/or subcomponents.

Dues Amount: Regular member dues are based on your total sales volume for structural building components manufactured at all of your member locations, that is, the most current year's sales of wood roof and floor trusses, wall panels, related structural components and/or subcomponents. Please refer to the chart at right to find your dues amount. [Note: all of this information is kept strictly confidential.]

Truss Plate Manufacturer Associate Member:

Any firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the manufacture, sale and distribution of metal connector plates for the wood truss industry.

Dues Amount: Truss plate manufacturer dues are based on the most current year total annual sales volume of truss plates, bent metal (i.e., hangers) and software licenses sold by Truss Plate Manufacturers (TPMs) to Regular Members. Please refer to the chart at right to find your dues amount.

Associate Member: Any firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of supplying products, equipment, machinery or services to manufacturers of wood roof and floor trusses, wall panels, related structural components and/or sub-components for use in their business, and who is interested in furthering the purposes of SBCA.

National Framers Council (NFC)

Framer Member: Any individual, firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of structural framing or installed sales of components. Annual Dues are based on total units framed.

Corporate Non-Framer Member: Any firm, partnership or corporation engaged in a business other than framing that is interested in furthering the goals of NFC. This includes builders, general contractors and those supplying materials and/or services to framers including, but not limited to, structural components, building materials, products, equipment, machinery or design. Annual Dues: National Member: \$1,025. Regional Member: \$615.

Individual Non-Framer Member: Any individual engaged in a business other than framing or installed sales who provides professional services to the framing industry and is interested in furthering the goals of NFC. This includes, but is not limited to, architects, engineers, building officials, educators, students, etc. Annual Dues: \$100

Associate Member: Any firm, partnership or corporation engaged in the business of supplying products, equipment, machinery or services to manufacturers of cold-formed steel roof and floor trusses, wall panels, related structural components and/or subcomponents for use in their business, and who is interested in furthering the purposes of SBCA.
